Program Delivery

As of October 29th, we have 18 school groups signed up to bring 1566 students and 181 chaperones. 10 of the schools have attended before while 5 new schools have applied. An additional 475 young people aged 7-15 and 87 chaperones have signed up from 24 Sparks, Brownies, Girl Guide, Pathfinders, Cubs, and Scouts groups. Registration for schools is now full on Tuesday, but there are still school visits available for the Monday 8:50- 11:10am time slot.
