We are pleased to announce that **Earth Science for Society (ESfS)** will be hosting its 10th annual geoscience exhibition at the Big Four Building, Stampede Park, Calgary, on March 15-17, 2020. We would like to invite you and your students to come for a guided visit to this great event on Monday, March 16th or Tuesday, March 17th, 2020.

ESfS is a popular event showcasing the importance and impact of Earth Science in our everyday lives. Presenters at the four themed pavilions, *Resources and You*, *Energy for Us*, *One Dynamic Earth*, and *Our Future!*, give dynamic geoscience-related demonstrations, and visitors are invited to engage in the hands-on, interactive exhibits, which provide a unique learning experience for them. Students can also investigate all kinds of prospective careers.

Earth Science for Society supplements in-class studies for the grade 7 “the Planet Earth” unit and the grade 3 “Rocks and Minerals” unit. Participating schools and youth groups at all grade levels have told us that **ESfS** is a valuable science event for them. Every student will receive a Scavenger Hunt booklet to encourage interaction with the exhibitors. The Scavenger Hunt booklet will contain two sets of questions; for older students (grade 7) and for our younger visitors (grade 4). Teachers will be sent the questions and answers in advance. Geoscience guides will escort your students around the pavilions and help to answer any questions. The visit will start with a briefing and continue with a tour to the pavilions lasting approximately two hours. Homeschoolers will be put together or with a school group and are welcome to stay longer after the official guided visit.
