We are pleased to announce that **Earth Science for Society (ESfS)** will be hosting its 10th annual geoscience exhibition at the Big Four Building, Stampede Park, Calgary, on March 15-17, 2020. We would like to invite you and your Youth Group to take part in this great event on Sunday afternoon, March 15th, or the evening of Monday, March 16th, 2020.

ESfS is a popular event showcasing the importance and impact of Earth Science in our everyday lives, and is free and open to the public. Presenters at the four themed pavilions, *Resources and You*, *Energy for Us*, *One Dynamic Earth*, and *Our Future!*, give dynamic geoscience-related demonstrations, and visitors are invited to engage in hands-on, interactive exhibits, which provide a unique learning experience for them. There are also opportunities to explore many varied prospective careers.

Geoscience guides will escort your group around the pavilions and to the optional Geo-Theatre talk(s) on Sunday, and help to answer any questions. The visit will start with a briefing and continue with a tour to the pavilions lasting approximately two hours. The optional Geo-Theatre talks each add another half hour. Every visitor will receive a Scavenger Hunt booklet to encourage interaction with all the exhibitors. The Scavenger Hunt booklets will have two sets of questions; one for older children (grade 7) and one for our younger visitors (grade 4). Group leaders will be sent the questions and answers in advance. The grade 7 Scavenger Hunt booklet and programming of the event are aligned with the Girl Guide Alberta GeoScience Challenge badge, and Girl Guides who participate in the event will fulfill some of the requirements for this badge.
